1. Call to order

- a) Welcome and Introductions
- b) Review and approve February meeting minutes.
- c) Discussion on testing of Mail Chimp for sending newsletter.

2. Reports

- a) Treasurer
 - Update of balance for general fund, animal fund and garden fund, updated for purchases. No updates from fraud investigation, however, the money was returned. Dawn will know by April regarding 2022 Run for Raptors and Duck Hunt funds from Rec Desk.
 - ii. Request for current honey and syrup stock from BBNC.
- b) Social Media
 - Posting activity is consistent and website is now up and live.
- c) Park Operations
 - i. Deck at residential camp is almost complete.
 - ii. Working on 2023 Master Naturalist class which will start March 19th.





iii. Working with Outdoor School to plant 375 trees at the pavilion site in March and April. There will be a variety of species.

d) Nature Center

- Maple Fest preparations underway. There are 2 trees that are tapped. Friday training during field trip for tapping trees. Hikes will be every 30 minutes. No more trees will be tapped because they aren't producing anything.
- ii. Field trip training on March 25th at 10-12pm to help Jenna with April-June field trips.
- iii. Summer camp counselor applications will be reviewed next week. Camps are nearly full.
- iv. Animals are all doing well.

3. Old Business

- a) Gardens
 - i. Alison created a monthly newsletter for the gardens.
 - ii. Seeds are starting in greenhouse
 - iii. March 18th garden work day for 14 and up at 10am.

b) Events

- i. Maple Fest March 4 and 5. FHBB table and volunteers. Sticker, hike, and syrup sales via cash, check or Square. Volunteers still needed for Sunday. Chris asked that if the Square is used, to please ask for a \$1 donation to cover the card reader fee.
- ii. Adult Egg Hunt April 1st at 7:30pm. Still need volunteers the day-of to hide eggs from 3-5pm.
 \$20 per person. Event is on the white and green trail. Also need donations from community for the prizes and baskets for the hunt. Jenna will be the bunny, who will carry extra eggs.
 Event is sold out and has 45 people wait list.

c) Trails

- i. Ken attended Dept of Recreation and Parks Advisory Committee meeting regarding e-bikes in the parks. The committee will discuss the issue and make a decision. Class 1 is pedal-assist motor e-bikes. Class 2 is a throttle-motorized e-bike. Class 3 is throttle and limited to 28 mph. The concern is the throttle design can spin wheels and kick up mud and dirt (which ruin the trails)
- ii. Approval to open section of trail by Muddy Lane to make it a bit more safe near the road and will clear it on March 11th.
- iii. Mountain bike festival scheduled for June 3rd, with rain date of June 10th. Registration opens March 1st. There will be a long loop and a short loop.
- iv. In 2028, there are funds to survey Union Mills/Hashawha trails and determine which trails are sustainable.

d) T-shirts and Stickers

 Stickers are ready. They are \$2 each. T-shirts have been ordered – 30 of each kind. They will be ready in about 2 weeks.





e) Website

- i. Michelle noted that the garden page is difficult to find. Maggie will tweek the site so it's easier to find and create a drop down menu. Also will need to add events to the website. Guidelines for adopt a garden program also need to be added to the garden page.
- ii. Got approval from Jeff Degitiz on the website. Social media is not policed by the county, but will deal with negative comments professionally.

f) Scout Expo

 FHBB will have a table next to Piney Run. Need general park maps and other handouts, specifically activities that scouts can do. Mika is collecting all the handouts. Suggested that MORE join the expo.
