 - We received money from CCRP for duck hunt and other activities
 - Approved additional funding for garden account \$250
 - Alison may also request resin for the bowls she is making

- Park Operations- Dawn Harry
 - Pedestrian improvements have started, walkways
 - Tree planting in fields- about 40 left to plant
 - Switching swamp oaks for field oaks in field
 - DNR will be watering the new trees over the summer
- Nature Center- Jenna Mele
 - 120+ baby fingerling trout released several families joined, plus several master naturalists
 - A little macroinvertebrate study but water was high, fast
 - Opossum DNR decided to change the permit mammals used to go through feds, but the scientific collection permit changed so no nature centers can use opossums in the public for programs (3 opossums in MD had rabies). Environ lawyer is going to look into it.
 - New kestrel partial wing amputation may go to Piney Run
 - Kestrel and Screech owl may be coming from another rehabber, we have room for them
